Subject: **AUTHORIZE THE SUBMITTAL OF A PROJECT APPLICATION WITH  
THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR  
CORRIDOR MOBILITY IMPROVEMENT ACCOUNT FUNDS**

### **Recommendation**

The Finance-Auditing Committee recommends that the Board of Directors authorize the General Manager to submit a project application with the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) for Corridor Mobility Improvement Account (CMIA) Funds to support the Moveable Median Barrier capital project.

This recommendation will be presented to the Board of Directors at its December 15, 2006, meeting for appropriate action.

### **Summary**

On November 7, 2006, California voters approved Proposition 1B, the Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality and Port Security Bond Act of 2006. The bond includes \$4.5 billion for the CMIA program of the bond.

MTC is the designated agency for the San Francisco Bay Area to submit project nominations to the California Transportation Commission for funding under the CMIA program. MTC is currently soliciting CMIA program project nominations from the Bay Area County Congestion Management Agencies and Caltrans. MTC is also eligible to submit project nominations.

### **Fiscal Impact**

This item provides application for \$20 million in CMIA program funds to support implementation of the \$25 million Moveable Median Barrier project. This project is included in the District's 10-year capital plan (80% grant, 20% District funded).
