

**Deficit Reduction Strategy**  
**E. Additional Revenues From Public Sources**

Below are listed two potential ways to meet deficit reduction strategy **E. Additional Revenues From Public Sources**.

**I-Bond Funds:** It is unofficially projected that the District's share of the I-Bond capital funds will be approximately \$34 million over the next 10 years. Due to the uncertain nature of the estimate at the time the projection was put together only \$25 million was included. If the initial projection holds, it is possible that an additional *\$4.5 million could be available over the 5 year projection period.*

**Prop 42 Spillover Funds:** There is no guarantee that the District will receive more funds in any of 5 the years of the current projection but, if current economic conditions hold, monies could be come available. The District share of the spillover funds was approximately \$2.7 million in FY 07 and approximately \$1 million in FY 08.
