APPROVE THE REJECTION OF ALL BIDS RECEIVED FOR CONTRACT NO. 2013-FT-13, REFURBISHMENT OF THE M.S. SAN FRANCISCO FERRY

May 24, 2013

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (Board) of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (District) operates Golden Gate Transit ferry service; and,

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2013, the District issued an Invitation for Bids for Contract No. 2013-FT-13, *Refurbishment of the M.S. San Francisco Ferry* (Contract No. 2013-FT-13), and by the bid opening date of May 9, 2013, the District received bids from three shipyards in response to Contract No. 2013-FT-13; and,

WHEREAS, the lowest bid, which was submitted by Ice Floe, LLC, dba Nichols Brothers Boat Builders, included a bid bond that did not meet Contract No. 2013-FT-13 specifications; and,

WHEREAS, after consultation with the District's Attorney, the District determined that this material irregularity could not be waived, and therefore the District rendered the bid non-responsive; and,

WHEREAS, the second lowest bidder's total bid price was almost \$4 million more than the lowest bid and exceeded the District's estimate for the work; and,

WHEREAS, the third lowest bidder's total bid price was also around \$4 million more than the lowest bid and exceeded the District's estimate for the work; and,

WHEREAS, there being no other viable bids on the project to refurbish M.S. San Francisco (Project), District staff's recommendation is to reject all bids; and,

WHEREAS, when the Project is re-bid, the District shall clarify the Bid Bond requirements and adjust the scope of work, including the deletion of an option included in the existing specifications to refurbish a second vessel, to encourage bid prices within the District's estimated budget; and,

WHEREAS, there is no fiscal impact associated with this action, and the Project is included in the Ferry Transit Division Capital Budget at a total cost of \$10,000,000.00, and is 100% grant funded, with \$6,977,078.00 Federal Transit Administration grant funds and \$3,022,922 State I-Bond grant funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Building and Operating Committee at its meeting of May 24, 2013 has so recommended; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District hereby rejects all bids received for Contract No. 2013-FT-13, Refurbishment of the M.S. San Francisco Ferry.
