RESOLUTION NO. 2013-058

APPROVE THE FY 2013/2014 THROUGH 2015/2016 DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE GOAL ON FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION-ASSISTED PROJECTS

June 14, 2013

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (Board) of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (District) receives federal transportation funding for various projects, and as a condition of receiving such funding, the District must have a diversity program for the participation of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs) in District contracting opportunities; and,

WHEREAS, in the past, the District submitted annual reports to the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) that analyzed anticipated FTA-funded projects for potential DBE participation for the forthcoming fiscal year and set an annual overall DBE goal, after publication of the proposed goal and consideration of input from the general public; and,

WHEREAS, in March 2010, the U.S. Department of Transportation issued new regulations directing that henceforth, federal grant recipients shall instead set overall DBE goals on a three-year basis, and as such the District's goal methodology shall be submitted to the FTA every three years, instead of every year, based upon anticipated FTA-assisted contracts for the three forthcoming fiscal years; and,

WHEREAS, staff used an objective, two-step process to evaluate contract opportunities for projects anticipated to receive FTA funding during the next three fiscal years (Two-Step Process), listed herein as Attachment A; and,

WHEREAS, the first step of the evaluation process (Step One) yielded an overall DBE participation percentage by identifying the prime and subcontracting opportunities for each contract by the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes that closely match the types of work (prime contractors and subcontractors) required for the contracts, as well as by analyzing the relative availability of DBEs for those opportunities by comparing data from the California Unified Certification Program (CUCP) database of all certified DBEs with the U.S. Census Bureau's County Business Patterns database of all firms; and,

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WHEREAS, the second step of the evaluation process (Step Two) consisted of further adjustments to the overall DBE participation percentage by assessing known relevant evidence to narrowly tailor the base DBE participation figure to the District's marketplace, with such evidence possibly including actual DBE participation in the District's race- and gender-neutral contracts in recent years or other factors which could limit or expand the availability of DBEs to participate; and,

WHEREAS, interested parties may find a complete copy of the goal methodology detailing these steps by submitting a request to the Office of the District Secretary; and,

WHEREAS, the District anticipates that a total of fourteen FTA-assisted contracts shall be awarded in FY 13/14 through 15/16, totaling \$40.2 million, with two for the District Division, five for the Bus Transit Division and seven for the Ferry Transit Division; and,

WHEREAS, after Step One calculations, the base goal figure was 43%; and,

WHEREAS, Step Two adjustments affected five contracts, of which one pertained to dry-docking, one pertained to dredging, one pertained to structural bridge security implementation and two pertained to separate gangway and pier construction projects, with each contract requiring adjustment to its individual contract base figure due to its size, complexity or specialized nature; and,

WHEREAS, upon application of the Two-Step Process, staff recommends establishing a 5.9% overall DBE goal to be achieved using race-neutral methods, which the General Manager, or designee, shall publicly publish in a "Notice of Proposed Overall Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Goal for Fiscal Year 2013/2014 through 2015/2016," listed herein as Attachment B; and,

WHEREAS, interested parties may find a breakdown of relative DBE availability and base figures per contract in the aforementioned goal methodology, which may be obtained from the Office of the District Secretary; and,

WHEREAS, the Rules, Policy and Industrial Relations Committee at its meeting of June 14, 2013, has so recommended; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Board of Directors (Board) of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District hereby establishes, relative to the FY 2013/2014 through 2015/2016 overall Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goals on Federal Transit Administration (FTA) projects, a 5.9% proposed DBE goal applicable to \$40,224,000.00 in contracts assisted by the FTA and anticipated for the three forthcoming fiscal years; and, be it further

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RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the General Manager to publish notice of the proposed goal, in accordance with federal regulations governing the establishment of DBE goals; and, be it further

RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the General Manager to formally adopt the FTA goal if no public comments are received that require further consideration or modification of the proposed goal by the Board; and, be it further

RESOLVED that the Board authorizes staff to submit the District's overall DBE goal for FTA-assisted contracting opportunities to the FTA by August 1, 2013.

FY 2013/2014 through 2015/2016 Overall DBE Goal for FTA-Assisted Contracts

The availability figures determined for the FTA-assisted contracts were calculated into projected DBE participation dollars by taking the FTA dollars budgeted for each contract and multiplying by the availability figure for each contract. The total of the projected DBE participation dollars was then divided by the total of the budgeted FTA dollars for all contracts, resulting in a 5.9% overall goal.
