WHEREAS, DOT has developed guidelines for the purpose of administering and distributing PTMISEA funds to eligible project sponsors (local agencies); and,

WHEREAS, the District wishes to delegate authorization to execute these documents and any amendments thereto to the General Manager or his designee; and,

WHEREAS, the Finance-Auditing Committee, at its meeting of February 11, 2011, has so recommended; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Board of Directors (Board) of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway & Transportation District, authorizes the General Manager or his designee to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the attached Certification and Assurances document; and, be it further

RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the General Manager or his designee to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the applicable statutes, regulations and guidelines for all PTMISEA-funded transit projects; and be it further
