AUTHORIZE EXECUTION OF A THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE WIDE AREA NETWORK SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF MARIN

July 8, 2011

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (Board) of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (District), by Resolution No. 2008-089, at its meeting of October 10, 2008, authorized execution of an Agreement (Agreement) with the County of Marin, for a five-year term, to provide network services through the County of Marin's, "Marin.org/MIDAS network"; and,

WHEREAS, since execution of the Agreement, two amendments have been issued, the first to increase the original contract amount from \$466,150.00 to \$486,153.00 and the second, to modify the allocation of the bandwidth; and,

WHEREAS, upgrades are required to the bandwidth at the San Rafael Transit Center to support Call Center staff moving to that location, and to the bandwidth at the Larkspur Ferry Terminal; and,

WHEREAS, MAC addresses for ACIS addressable devices, and a new core VLAN, are required at the Marin County central network location to run the new ACIS "flat" network; and,

WHEREAS, the Finance-Auditing Committee, at its meeting of July 7, 2011, has so recommended; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors (Board) of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (District) hereby authorizes the execution of a Third Amendment to the Wide Area Network Services Agreement with the County of Marin, in the amount of \$68,816.00, to provide additional bandwidth and network capabilities, and to cover the additional costs of the remaining two years of a five-year Agreement, the term of which concludes on October 31, 2013, and, be it further

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RESOLVED, that sufficient funds are available in the FY 11/12 District Division Operating Budget and that future years will be budgeted accordingly.
