## APPROVE "OPTION C2" FOR THE OUTDOOR EXHIBITION AREA RELATIVE TO THE NATIONAL SCIENCE FOUNDATION PROJECT'S MASTER PLAN FOR THE EAST VISITOR'S AREA

January 22, 2010

WHEREAS, the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (District), in collaboration with the Consortium of Universities for Research in Earthquake Engineering (CUREE), and in partnership with Princeton University, Stanford University, San Jose State University, the Sciencenter (Ithaca, NY), the Exploratorium (San Francisco, CA), Eyethink, West Wind Laboratory, EHDD Architecture (San Francisco, CA), the American Public Works Association and the International Bridge, Tunnel and Turnpike Authority was awarded a grant in the amount of \$2,999,777.00 from the National Science Foundation (NSF), grant award No. DLRL-0840185, for *The Golden Gate Bridge as an Informal Science Education Resource*; and,

WHEREAS, the Golden Gate Bridge's south side Visitor Area currently offers very limited learning opportunities for its more than 10 million annual visitors, and for many years there has been a strong need for a permanent outdoor exhibition at this site; and,

WHEREAS, the principle work of the NSF grant is the development and installation outdoor exhibits that inform visitors about the science, engineering and history of the Golden Gate Bridge; and,

WHEREAS, the NSF grant also includes the development of a Master Plan for the Visitor Area at the south side of the Golden Gate Bridge (Bridge) to ensure that the placement of the exhibits at the Bridge site is professionally guided and to ensure that this phase follows logical steps that could later lead to the realization of a Visitor Center at the site; and,

WHEREAS, several potential locations were identified and evaluated for the location of the outdoor science-oriented exhibits; and,

WHEREAS, Option "C" is located within Battery Lancaster; and,

WHEREAS, Option "C2" modifies Option C by removing a wedge from the north facing Battery Lancaster concrete wall, providing an accessible path of travel and views of the Bridge; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors, at its meeting of January 22, 2010, under Item No. 10.A. SPECIAL ORDER OF BUSINESS, has so recommended; now, therefore, be it
