WHEREAS, the Sonoma-Marin Area Rail Transit (SMART) District was created by state legislation in 2002 for the purpose of re-establishing passenger train service on the historic Northwestern Pacific Railroad right of way in Sonoma and Marin counties; and,

WHEREAS, the establishment of passenger train service will provide a viable alternative to automobile transportation, as well as provide a safe north-south pathway for bicycles as well as pedestrians; and,

WHEREAS, the SMART Board has placed Measure Q, authorizing a quarter-cent sales tax to fund the project on the November ballot; and,

WHEREAS, the Bridge District has been a long-time supporter of the preservation of the rail corridor as evidenced through its leadership role in the acquisition of major sections the historic right-of-way followed by ownership transfer of the right-of-way to the SMART District; and,

WHEREAS, the Bridge District is directly represented on the SMART Board of Directors and has been an active partner in the development of the planned rail program referenced in Measure Q; and,

WHEREAS, the Governmental Affairs and Public Information Committee, at its meeting of October 10, 2008, has so recommended; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED** that the Board of Directors of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District hereby approves support of the Sonoma-Marin Area Rail Transit (SMART) District's one-quarter percent sales tax initiative (Measure Q) to fund the passenger train and pathway project.
