**APPLY FOR MEMBERSHIP ON THE TJPA CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE
APPLICATIONS DUE FEBRUARY 29, 2008**

Dear Bay Area Residents:

The Transbay Joint Powers Authority (TJPA) is soliciting applications from Bay Area residents interested in being considered to serve on the TJPA Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC).

On April 10, 2007, the Transbay Joint Powers Authority Board held an inaugural meeting of Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) consisting of 15 voting members representing specific categories which reflect the many local and regional groups interested in the Transbay Transit Center Program. To preserve continuity, it was determined that the expirations of initial terms would be staggered, and seven members were randomly selected to serve an initial one year term. Thereafter, all terms will be for a period of two years. Each member is eligible to serve a maximum of three consecutive terms.

The TJPA CAC meets on the second Tuesday of the month at the Yerba Buena Center of the Arts at 701 Mission Street, San Francisco. Meetings start at 5:30 PM. Consistent attendance is required.

The members whose terms are expiring this year include representatives of the following constituencies:

- *Member with expertise in real estate development or real estate finance.*
- *Local Business from District 6*
- *Regional Transit advocate (2 seats)*
- *Environmentalist*
- *San Francisco based public transit advocate*
- *Member of a planning or good-government non-profit organization*

Members whose terms are expiring have the opportunity to reapply for their current category and/or any of the above categories that their experience makes them eligible for. Staff will review applications and make recommendations to the TJPA Board of Directors.
