WHEREAS, the Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Bond Act of 2006 authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds for specified purposes, including, but not limited to, funding made available for capital projects that provide increased protection against security and safety threats, and for capital expenditures to increase the capacity of transit operators to develop disaster response transportation systems; and,

WHEREAS, the California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA) administers such funds deposited in the Transit System Safety, Security, and Disaster Response Account under the California Transit Security Grant Program (CTSGP); and,

WHEREAS, the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (District) is eligible to receive CTSGP funds; and,

WHEREAS, the District will apply for FY 2012/2013 CTSGP funds in an amount up to \$802,488.00 for the Advanced Communications and Information System (ACIS) which supports the purpose of the Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Bond Act of 2006; and,

WHEREAS, the District recognizes that it is responsible for compliance with all Cal EMA CTSGP grant assurances, and state and federal laws, including, but not limited to, laws governing the use of bond funds; and,

WHEREAS, Cal EMA requires the District to complete and submit a Governing Body Resolution for the purposes of identifying agent(s) authorized to act on behalf of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District to execute actions necessary to obtain CTSGP funds from Cal EMA and ensure continued compliance with Cal EMA CTSGP assurances, and state and federal laws; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District here authorizes Denis J. Mulligan, General Manager, and/or his designee, to execute for and on behalf of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District, a public entity established under the laws of the State of
